



## KRYISIA'S WEB BOOKS SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Kryisia's Web Books (KWB) publishes eBooks in three lengths: Short (10K-30K words), Mid-length or Novellas (30K-50K words), and Novels (50K words +). Word count, however, is not the main concern at KWB. The main concern is a well-written, good, readable story, regardless of its length. Remember that KWB focuses on *romance only*. The sub-genre of romance does not matter; your story can be historical, contemporary, fantasy/sci-fi, homosexual, or heterosexual, multi-racial, and so forth, provided that its main bent is romance. However, KWB does *not* publish within the "Inspirational" (i.e. religious themed) sub-genre. Keep in mind that love scenes are not required (if the romance story does not call for them). If your work does include love scenes, just keep in mind that KWB is a romance ePublisher and *not* an erotica ePublisher.

Royalties range from 40%-45% of the download price of the book sold (provided the book is sold through KWB's website, Kryisia's Web at [www.kryusiasweb.net](http://www.kryusiasweb.net)). (See the Author's Contract for further detail regarding royalties.) Download prices in USD (United States Dollars) are as follows: \$3.00 Short (10K-30K words), \$4.50 Mid-length or Novellas (30K-50K words), and \$6.00 Novels (50K words +). The price may be higher for "epic" romances.

Kryisia's Web Books does *not* offer any advances.

### Accepted Genres:

*Contemporary*: Romances that take place in the present dealing with problems that people face today, but keeping romance as the center of the plot.

*Futuristic*: Romances that take place in the near or distant future, situated on Earth or on another planet/galaxy, but keeping romance as the center of the plot.

*Historical*: Romances that span any timeline from B.C. to 1960 A.D. Details must be accurate and the plotline true to the time period; however, please don't overkill on the descriptions as it would bore the reader. Romance is the center of the plot.

*Regency*: Romances set in the Regency era (1811-1820). See above regarding details. Romance is the center of the plot.

*Romantic Suspense/Action-Adventure:* Please avoid the “damsel in distress rescued by her hero” cliché. Keep the situations believable and the characters and plot interesting. Remember to close up any suspenseful threads loose within the story. Romance is the center of the plot.

*Paranormal/Time Travel/Fantasy:* Romances that deal with ESP, vampires, werewolves, gargoyles, witches, centaurs, dragons and other mystical creatures, magic, and traveling through time. Whether your interest is to make the reader shiver with dread, trepidation, anticipation, or sheer delight, remember to keep romance the essence of the story. Remember that “special effects” can be fun, distracting, and thrilling within a story, but do not distract from bad writing.

*Other:* If you have a romance of a sub-genre not listed here, or if you are unsure into which sub-genre your story fits, contact me (krysia@krysiaweb.net). It may still qualify. If you’re a writer like me, you often combine several elements of the above-listed sub-genres into one story.

**To offer your manuscript for submission:**

KWB DOES *NOT* ACCEPT SUBMISSIONS OF WORK IN PROGRESS. PLEASE HAVE YOUR BOOK FINISHED!

1. Write a professional cover letter (*not* an email). Due to the grotesque amounts of spam email, KWB uses several spam-blockers. If you write an email letter initially, it’s highly likely it won’t ever make it past the blockers. Also, your initial cover letter will —upon acceptance— be the start of your file on record with Krysia’s Web Books. This is your best work; you’ve spent weeks, months, even years pouring your soul into it. It deserves a formal introduction. Give KWB and your work, a good first impression.

The cover letter must include the following:

*Your Name*

*Your Home Address*

*Your Telephone Number*

*Your Fax Number (if applicable)*

*Your Email*

*Your Website URL (if applicable)*

*Title of your Book*

*Genre, Sub-Genre*

*Word Count*

Include in the cover letter, a short overview of your story or subject. Include a little about yourself, such as your writing background. Also include whether or not you have illustrations (see Contract) and/or cover art for your work. Enclose a synopsis of your book which describes your story from beginning to end. Do *not* send KWB a chapter-by-chapter synopsis unless requested to do so.

Once you have written your cover letter, if you have included your email address, you should hear back (via email) from KWB within seven days. If KWB is interested, the reply email will include a request for the first three chapters of your manuscript. Save this as *one* file in MS WORD or RTF and attach it to your reply email. Do *not* include it within the email itself. KWB does *not* accept any other format than the two stated. At the beginning of the partial, include your name, contact information, and title of the manuscript. When you save and/or attach the file, please save it with the title of the manuscript included.

Please remember to scan your files for viruses and cyber worms prior to sending it over the Web. KWB will also scan all emails and their attached files for viruses and cyber worms. Any emails/attachments found infected will be deleted immediately (without being opened), so make sure your work and transmissions are clean.

Kryisia's Web Books' schedule at present is the following, subject to change depending on workload: KWB will notify you that your cover letter was received. At that time, you will be asked for sample chapters or rejected (but in a nice way). If KWB wishes to request the entire manuscript, we will be back in touch with you (anywhere from days to within six weeks). Please do *not* send email after email inquiring about the status of your manuscript. However, if you have not heard back from KWB by five weeks, feel free to send an email.

**Next step:**

Kryisia's Web Books does *not* accept submissions of work in progress. Please have your book finished! Self-edit your book. It must be spell-checked and grammatically correct. Present your work at its best. We will check your book for errors, and we may edit your book, but look at the editing process as a joint effort between Author and Publisher.

When KWB requests your complete manuscript, we will accept it in the following format *only*:

12 point Times New Roman font  
Page break at the end of a chapter  
Chapter headings in 14 point "bold" Times New Roman

No page numbers  
No headers or footers  
Use *italics* instead of underlining  
Use tabs when indenting, not spaces

Save the file(s) in Microsoft Word or RTF (rich text format) *only*. If the submission is not sent in either of these formats, *we will not consider the manuscript* at all.

Our eBooks (at this time) are in PDF and Adobe Acrobat eBook Reader formats. KWB does not offer eBooks in HTML format as we do not believe HTML format offers the same degree of copyright protection as the two former formats. Files are delivered zipped and/or stuffed for ease of download.
